

Ultraflash – Danish Shipping Employment

In 2019, Danish Shipping companies employ 24.437 persons. 6.788 persons are land-based employees in Denmark while 17.649 persons are employed at sea. The Danish shipping industry is experiencing growth both at sea and onshore.

- According to a recent survey by Danish Shipping of employment within the membership, there is 24.437 persons employed in the Danish Shipping industry. Compared to last year, the employment is increased by 1.487 persons corresponding to 6 pct.
- A large part of the increase in the Danish shipping industry employment is driven by activities at sea. Thus, compared to last year additional 856 seafarers are employed in the Danish shipping industry. Of those 108 are Danish seafarers, 127 are EU seafarers and 621 are seafarers with another nationality.
- Also, onshore employment has increased. The shipping land-based employment in Denmark has grown by 631 persons compared to last year. Approximately 408 persons of the increase are due to new members in Danish Shipping. The rest is due to organic growth in the Danish shipping companies.
- Each year Danish Shipping conducts a member survey about employment in each of the approximately 100 member companies. The companies specify the nationality, rank and gender of the persons employed.
