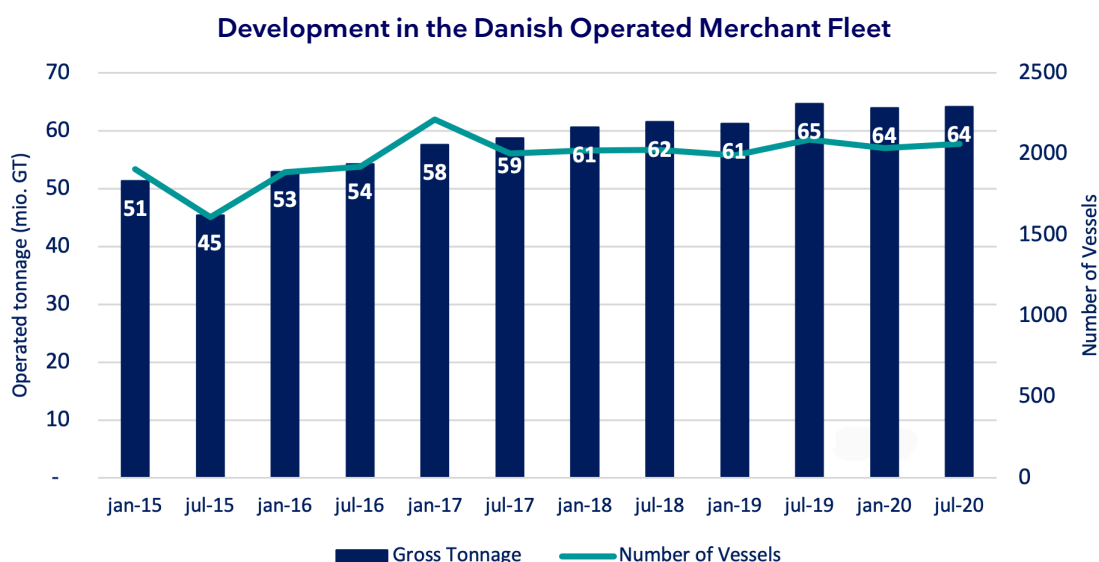
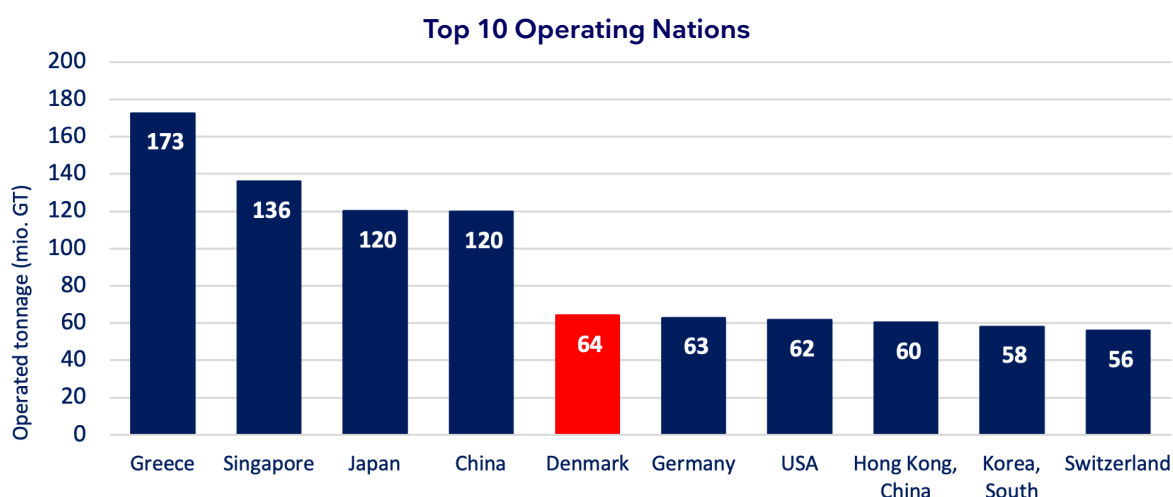


Ultraflash – Stability in the Danish Operated Merchant Fleet 2020

In spite of challenges posed by the global COVID-19 crisis, the Danish operated merchant fleet continues at a stable level, thus maintaining the position as the world’s fifth largest merchant fleet, measured on ships operated by Danish shipping companies .

- In July 2019 the Danish operated merchant fleet took a step up on the list of the world’s largest shipping nations and replaced the US merchant fleet.
- By 1. July 2020, Danish shipping companies operate 2,064 vessels with a total of 64.2 million gross tonnage. A 25 pct. increase in Danish operated tonnage since January 2015.
- The Danish operated merchant fleet represents 4.5 pct. of the total global merchant fleet, which consists of more than 98,300 vessels corresponding to 1.42 billion gross tonnage.
